Subject: Mandatory Registration of Drones/ Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) in District Una.

It has come to the notice of the undersigned that the operation and possession of drones/Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) within the jurisdiction of District Una are being carried out without adequate regulatory oversight. In view of prevailing security concerns, public safety considerations, and the need for accountability and transparency in drone operations, it is imperative to regulate the use of drones in the district.

Therefore, I, Jatin Lal, IAS, Chairman DDMA-cum-District Magistrate, Una, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Sections 33 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, do hereby issue the following directions for immediate compliance:

1. All individuals, private entities, institutions, and government agencies currently in possession of drones within District Una shall register their drones at the jurisdictional Police Thana (Police Station) within 7 (seven) days from the date of issuance of this order.
2. All newly acquired drones, including those procured in the future, must be registered at the jurisdictional Police Thana (Police Station) within seven (7) days from the date of procurement.
3. The registration application must contain the following details:
 - Drone Make and Model.
 - Serial Number (if applicable).
 - Range/Operating Capacity.
 - Intended Purpose of Use (e.g. agriculture, photography, surveillance, emergency response, etc.).
 - Details of Operator (Name, Contact Information, Address).
 - Copy of Remote Pilot License (if required as per Drone Rules).
4. The Officer-in-Charge of each Police Thana is directed to maintain a dedicated register (physical and/ or digital) for drone registration and submit a consolidated report to the Office of Superintendent of Police, Una.

This order shall come into immediate effect. Strict action shall be taken against any individual or organization found violating these directives under the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and other applicable laws.
